STANDING WITH VP WALTER ARE AGENTS PAINTON, GUSTAW AND LEWIS ALONG WITH CAROLINE.

WE LEARNED A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE ATF STARTING FROM THE HIRING PROCESS AND THE 6 MONTHS BASIC TRAINING. THEY REVIEWED THE MANY SWORN POSITIONS AND THE FEW CIVILIAN POSITIONS THAT ARE NEEDED TO BE SUCCESSFUL. AGENTS DUG INTO FIREARM INVESTIGATIONS INCLUDING TRAFFICKING (WHERE MANY WIND UP WITH THE CARTELS IN MEXICO); STRAW PURCHASING, THE SHOT SPOTTER SYSTEM (WHICH METRO ALSO USES THROUGHOUT THE VALLEY) AND THE NATIONAL INTEGRATED BALLISTIC INFORMATION NETWORK (NIBIN). THAT NETWORK IS USED BY ENTERING INFORMATION FROM FOUND SHELL CASINGS AT CRIME SCENES ALONG WITH FIRED SHELLS WHEN GUNS ARE RECOVERED AND COMPARING THEM FOR MATCHES-SIMILAR TO FINGER PRINTS ON PEOPLE-ALL UNIQUE. WE WERE INFORMED OF THE ATF CANINE PROGRAM WITH SPECIALTIES IN EXPLOSIVE DETECTION, ACCELERANT DETECTION, AND SEARCH ENHANCED. CANINE HANDLER PAINTON ALONG WITH CAROLINE THEN SHOWED US A LIVE DEMONSTRATION.



Dick Bennett Memorial Community Service Award

The Dick Bennett Memorial Community Service Award is awarded annually to the Las Vegas Metro Police Department Citizens' Police Academy Alumni Association (CPAAA) member who demonstrates the quality and character exemplified by Dick Bennett in community service to the City of Las Vegas and Clark County.

Dick Bennett, who passed away on 6 June 2017, served with distinction as the President of the CPAAA from March 2002 – June 2017. During his tenure, the CPAAA saw its membership increase as well as the money raised to support various police department initiatives.

Dick also worked to raise the awareness of various divisions within the LVMPD to CPAAA membership. The CPAAA has organized trips to prisons, the coroner's office as well as other civic organizations. In addition to the time he devoted to the CPAAA, Dick also served as a LVMPD Volunteer and "leading by example," he volunteered over 22,000 hours of public service to the Police Department.

Each year, the Board of Directors will identify one CPAAA member as the recipient of the Dick Bennett Memorial Community Service Award from the applications submitted. This individual is someone who is not currently serving on the CPAAA Board of Directors; not only an active member of the CPAAA, but also works in the community as a volunteer through the Metro Volunteer Program or other community service organization, which supports the citizens of Las Vegas and the surrounding Clark County. Members in good standing of the CPAAA are encouraged to nominate someone they feel is deserving of the award and applications will be submitted by the end of the current year.

The Dick Bennett Memorial Community Service Award will occur annually at the CPAAA February monthly meeting. The award winner will receive an inscribed plaque presented by the Sheriff commending that individual for his or her service to the LVMPD and the greater Las Vegas community.


