What is a TIP volunteer?

TIP volunteers are called by local police, fire, medical and hospital personnel to respond to scenes of sudden or unexpected death (natural, homicide, suicide, child, accidental, etc.) violent crimes, sexual assaults, and other traumatic incidents to provide emotional and practical support to family, friends, witnesses and victims.

What are the requirements?

- ·Must be 18 years old
- ·Clean driving record
- ·Clean criminal background
- ·Attend 36-hour training
- ·Pass 3-month field training
