

LVCFAAA Membership Expectations

These are guidelines to help answer CFAAA Alumni questions and follow for the betterment of each of us as we grow this association.

1. Wear your green CFAAA logo shirt, jacket at CFAAA meetings and functions. Please do not purchase logo wear (shirts, jackets, etc.) as gifts for family or friends if they are not CFAAA members. Be cognizant of where you are seen wearing our shirts in public, (not in a bar or a casino). Dress for the Holiday Fund Raiser is festive. Dress for dining with our dignitaries is logo wear or business casual.
2. Feel free to bring a guest over 18 years old to our meetings so they can share in your experience and encourage them to attend the CPA class and ultimately join CFAAA.
3. Sign in at the front door for regular meetings or with the Field Trip Coordinator. Have your CFAAA photo ID or other legal form of ID.
4. Please RSVP with the Field Trip coordinator and show up to field trips you signed up for. Many field trips have a limit on how many can attend. If you have to cancel, notify the Field Trip coordinator as soon as possible so they can attempt to fill the spot. If you fail to notify the coordinator of an impending absence you stand to lose future field trip privileges.
5. Pay your annual dues by January 15th of each calendar year.
6. Remember that your Board of Directors speak with one voice to ensure all members are treated fairly and respectfully.
7. We invite guest speakers due to their association with law enforcement, not to share their political affiliations. During the Q & A segment, ensure your questions are related to the subject matter.

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8. Whenever bidding on auction experiences, ensure you are flexible in your availability for the impending event. We are at the mercy of the LVMPD or CLV departments/bureaus schedules and officer training takes priority. We go as a group, so once the experience is scheduled, if a member cannot attend for whatever reason, 1) we request you treat it as a donation to the association, 2) in cases of last minute life events, we attempt to help you choose a mutually agreeable option, or 3) you have the right to appeal it to the Board of Directors for a final decision. We do our best to ensure all members have ample notice of auction experience dates to give the member plenty of time to reschedule existing commitments if necessary.

9. Feel free to participate in helping the Board of Directors by volunteering to assist with events such as the annual fundraiser, K9 trials booth, and the CPAAA store before monthly meetings. With your help, we work smarter. We often seek out members with special talents and skill sets to give us that needed extra help with unique abilities.

10. Consider getting more involved with CPAAA by running for a Board of Director seat.

11. Have fun at all CPAAA meetings, functions and field trips.

12. Avoid bringing guests under the age of 18 to meetings due to the sensitive nature of the topics covered by some of our guest speakers.

13. We respectfully ask that debit cards not be used as a form of payment. By using cash, check, Visa, Mastercard, Discover, AMEX or Zelle, the association avoids additional processing fees.
